Why Should You Get Tested?

- Approximately 1 in 4 people with HIV are not aware that they are infected.
- It is estimated that 1.2 million people are living with AIDS and HIV in the United States.
- **IF** you have been infected you can find out before you infect someone else.
- Treatment is more effective when HIV is detected early, which can prolong your life.
- It is quick and easy-no needles! Results in 20 minutes!
- **Everyone** should get tested regularly.
- AIDS is currently the fourth cause of death worldwide, with the number of cases on the **RISE**.
