# TO: HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER

Members of the Budget & Appropriations committee proposed further additions to the 2016 Operating Budget by the Democratic Caucus. These further additions, which total less than \$7.9 million, were subsequently accounted for with the addition of \$12.5 million in revenue through the sale of the building located on Austin Avenue in Yonkers. \$126,000 of additional Federal and State funding would also have become available as an offset to expenditures by April's Child. The deletion of April's child will prevent Westchester from realizing those much needed revenues.

This budget includes revenue projections from other real property sales (375 Executive Blvd in Yonkers) for which no contract of sale exists and which has not yet been completed. The accrual of revenues in the County Executive's proposed budget is no different than the accrual from the Austin Avenue sale. \$12.5 million is a conservative estimate of the County's prospective share and would go a long way to preserving services and restoring fund balance. This \$12.5 million number is based on a low estimate of the county's portion of the proceed from the building.

As explained by CBAC and the County's independent auditors to this committee, the sales tax revenues in the 2015 Operating Budget was vastly over estimated 2016 projection of 4% growth in sales tax will net similar results. Nassau and Suffolk Counties and many of our local municipalities budget for roughly 1-2% in Sales Tax revenues in the current economic climate, further evidence that projections of 4% are over optimistic to the point of being fiscally irresponsible.

The committee was also informed of various additions to the 2016 Operating Budget by the Democratic members of the Budget & Appropriations Committee. One of these additions was for the April's Child program: is a program that provides support to volunteer families and seeks to reduce incidents of child abuse and neglect in Westchester County. This program's total cost is \$204,340 and

would trigger offsetting revenue of \$126,000 in State and Federal grants if the program was voted for in the affirmative. Both the program and the additional revenue were not approved by the committee because of a 5-5 tie.

Cuts in the public safety department will reduce the number of patrols that the County Police will provide. At a time when threats to the public are increasing and the public seeks reassurance, cuts to the safety of our County's residents are severely misguided. A motion to restore funding for these patrols failed.

Many of the participants in Bravehearts program by Family Ties of Westchester have disabilities which require additional services to ensure a safe place to stay and employment is provided to these young adults in need. A year in residential treatment can cost \$130,000 or more per person, a day in a psychiatric hospital can cost about \$1,000 per person, and it costs Family Ties about \$1,000 per family for a year of services.

The committee was also informed of the Democratic Caucus' intent to restore \$106,090 in funding to Community Capital New York's Small Business Loan Program. These small loans are described as "but for" loans, but for these loans many of these small business start-ups would cease to exist. Community Capital has provided over \$3,000,000 to nearly 200 small businesses in Westchester County, grossing roughly \$13,327,000 in sales annually and created over 450 jobs. Any actor that says they are planning on stimulating the local economy by driving small businesses would support these funds. The votes against this funding are inconsistent with those statements.

You will see the complete list of the Democratic Caucus proposed adds on the attached spreadsheet, which includes the previously discussed items herein and others shown.

The Democratic members of the Budget and Appropriations Committee believe that the 2016 Operating Budget is structurally imbalanced. Sales tax revenues are grossly over projected and additional revenues are arbitrarily left out, which will result in further raiding of our fund balance. Additionally, the Democratic Caucus fears that this budget, and its subsequent raid of the fund balance, will lead to further downgrades of the county's bond rating in 2016. The Democratic Caucus believes this budget, unwisely cuts public safety and social programs alike, is fiscally irresponsible, lacks strategic vision and future planning, and is not in the best interest of the taxpayers of Westchester County.
