

RB03X Louisa Street over Hudson Division Railroad, Peekskill (BIN 2262400)

- Structure was built in 1984, bridge is 191' long by 44' wide
- Rehabilitation will consist of concrete repairs to superstructure, piers and abutments, replacement of wearing course and bridge joints
- Bridge Condition Rating 4.93 (2014); AADT 7,835

RB04B Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway, Rye (BIN 2000050)

- Structure was in 1941, bridge is 60' long by 70' wide
- Replacement will be a new precast rigid arch structure to allow for improved clearance
- Bridge Condition Rating 4.5 (2017); AADT 10,300




