New Initiatives & Highlights

- The Board is now required by NYS Election Law Part 6211 Early Voting Regulations to implement Early Voting throughout Westchester County for 9 days before any Primary, General and Special Elections in the County. The Board shall designate early voting sites for all elections and ensure that all voting sites are ADA compliant. The Board will be implementing the use of Electronic pollbooks for use in all Primary and General Elections next year including the Presidential Primary Election.
- The Board will implement an Early Voting Communication Plan by providing Early Voting Information to media outlets such as the newspapers and tv media. The Board's voter outreach methods will include all Board of Elections registration notification cards such as mail check cards, address change cards. The plans will be shared with VoteEarlyNY and the League of Women Voters. Flyers will be distributed to all Post Offices, Libraries, and Town/City/Village/School District Clerks.
