New Initiatives & Highlights

- Public Works will focus on increasing operational efficiencies and identifying cost savings during the upcoming fiscal years in support of the County's cost cutting efforts
 - Consolidate the Road Maintenance Division's Fleet Repairs with the Fleet Services Division
 - Right-Sizing steps for vehicle fleet (reuse, repurposing of vehicles).
 - Replacement of leaking high pressure steam line at Valhalla Campus. Improvements to the operating system controls, thereby increasing efficiency.
- Capital Planning group will be created within the Engineering Division
 - Three program planning positions will be transferred from the County Parks Department to work in this group.
