Core Programs & Functions

- Community supervision of high, medium and low risk offenders
- Specialized supervision units for Sex Offenders, Domestic Violence, DWI, Mental Health, High Impact, DTATI (Drug Treatment), Veterans
- Victim's Assistance unit to support victims through outreach, safety planning, impact statement preparation and court appearances
- Restitution collection and disbursement to crime victims
- Preparation of pre-sentence investigations for all criminal courts in Westchester



In Family Court:

- Assist petitioners with requests for Orders of Protection, Child Support, Custody and Visitation, Writs, PINS Warrants
- Prepare pre-disposition investigations for all Family Courts
- Conduct Custody, Adoption and Guardianship investigations
- Work with community partners to adjust cases to reduce placements of juveniles and adolescent offenders, lowering cost to taxpayers and improving outcomes for children
- Supervise Raise the Age youth (16-17) and Young Offenders (18-24)
