Core Programs & Functions

DPS is responsible for patrolling:

- Bronx River, Saw Mill, Hutchinson River and Cross County Parkways
- The county park system
- County facilities (e.g. MOB-1, Grasslands, etc.)
- Westchester County Airport
- · DSS offices
- Westchester Community College
- Several county homeless shelters
- Municipalities that contract for police services
 - Currently Cortlandt and Mount Kisco
- School districts that contract for School Resource Officers
 - Currently Lakeland, Somers, Hendrick Hudson and North Salem
 - Presently, we have 9 officers assigned to schools in these districts
 - Additionally, we have 1 College Resource Officer assigned to WCC
- COVID Vaccine Location at County Center

Aid to Locals

- Training
- Investigative Services

Real Time Crime Center

- Currently, 48 agencies participate, including all full-time municipal agencies in Westchester, as well as NYPD, MTA, and the FBI
- Since October 2017 over 17,077 requests for assistance from other agencies
- Responsible for the arrest of 538 suspects for multiple offenses, including robbery, burglary, and grand larceny, and recovery of more than 395 stolen vehicles
- MACS (Multi Agency Coordination System) operates out of RTC
 - Critical in coordinating local municipalities response to COVID-19 and Civil Unrest

 - Marine Unit
 - Special Response Team (SWAT)

 - Drug Recognition Experts
 - Crime Scene Processing and Analysis
 - The Police Academy
 - Recruit Training all recruits in Westchester and Putnam
 - Unified In-Service Training presently 30 departments participate
 - Project Lifesaver
- Uniformed and investigative personnel with highly specialized training
- Mutual aid manpower
- Backup 911 call-taking

COVID-19 Response

- Additional responsibilities
 - Patrol
 - In 2021, PSD assisted in securing the COVID testing site at Glen Island, the vaccination site at the County Center, and additional COVID sites throughout the County, staffing as many as sixteen (16) officers per day.
 - These details amounted to 5,880 hours of straight time and 24,087 hours of overtime through the end of the 3rd quarter
 - PSD presently staffs the County Center security detail, and anticipates this to continue into 2022, with three (3) officers per day as long as vaccines and boosters are still being administered.
 - SOD
 - SOD conducted 1896 decontamination jobs in 2021; 917 vehicles and 959 office spaces.
 - SOD maintaining decontamination personnel and equipment going into 2022.



New Initiatives & Highlights

Project: New Records Management System

Axon Fleet Cameras

- Replacing in-car video camera equipment
- Smaller hardware footprint will reduce installation costs
- Support payments provide for the automatic upgrade of equipment as it reaches end of life
- In-car video footage will be accessed through the same web-based application as the body-worn camera footage, which will streamline the discovery and FOIL process
- Fleet Computer Tablets Replacing all in-car tablets (part of camera project)
