2. A100: Mortgage Tax Receipts: Proposed Act authorizing the Commissioner of the Westchester County Department of Finance to pay Mortgage Tax Receipts to Cities, Towns and Villages.

3. A101: Certiorari Tax Refunds: Forwarding an information package of court ordered Certiorari Tax Refunds.

4. A95: Cellphone Surcharge Funds: Proposed Act authorizing the expenditure of \$6,097,374 in Cellphone surcharge funds for the operation of the T-136 system in Westchester County for the year 2007.

5. C184: Bond Act: Proposed act authorizing the County to issue bonds in the total amount of \$1,200,000 to finance Capital Project BIT3A-Desktop Systems 2007-2011.

7. C158: Bond Act: Authorizing the issuance of \$1,610,000 in bonds for: County-wide Office Renovations (B021B).
