(6299) **DEF** – Request authority to enter into a license agreement with the New York Water Board, granting the County the right to access the Catskill/Delaware Ultraviolet (“UV”) Disinfection Facility via two 48” diameter water pipes (the “Connection Work”) located on New York City (the “City”) Department of Environmental Protection’s (“DEP”) Eastview site adjacent to the Grasslands Reservation to obtain a supply of UV treated water, commencing upon execution until full maturity of the issuance of New York City Municipal Water Finance Authority bonds financing construction by DEP of the Connection Work, approximately thirty (30) years, for a license fee of \$5,064,000, in accordance with the listed terms and conditions.
