

## COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SAFETY & SECURITY

**MINUTES: October 29, 2007 -- 9:00am**

With a quorum present, the Committee on Public Safety & Security was called to order at 9:10 a.m.

County Department of Emergency Services (DES) Commissioner, Tony Sutton, and Deputy DES Commissioner, John DiBlasi were present to discuss the County's emergency equipment.

The Committee then reviewed the following agenda items, which were moved by Legislator Kaplowitz and seconded by Legislator Pinto --- Items 77 and 78 were signed out *without prejudice* by Legislator Swanson (4-0):

75. IMA: Proposed Act authorizing the County, acting by and through its Department of Emergency Services, to enter into Intermunicipal Agreements with one or more of the municipalities located in Westchester County wherein the County will distribute to the municipalities specialized equipment.

76. IMA: Proposed Act authorizing the County, acting by and through its Department of Emergency Services, to enter into Intermunicipal Agreements with one or more Westchester municipalities whereby the municipality will use and operate one or more of the County's specialized trailers to assist the County's emergency response efforts by providing deployment and support services during a disaster.

77. IMA-Mt. Vernon: Proposed Act authorizing the County to enter into an eighteen month IMA with the City of Mt. Vernon for the provision of a juvenile violent crime reduction program.

78. IMA-Peekskill: Proposed Act authorizing the county to enter into an IMA with the City of Peekskill in order to provide reimbursement for prisoner transportation to the Westchester County Jail.

The minutes for the Committee's 9am meeting on June 25, 2007 were not approved.

At 9:40am, on the motion of Legislator Kaplowitz and seconded by Legislator Jenkins, the Committee on Public Safety & Security meeting was adjourned.
